As of January 24th, school shifts to an exam/homework schedule.

- Grade 9s students who have outstanding work as of Tuesday, January 23rd will need to come to school for an 8:45 am start each day during exam week and stay in Red Quad until they are caught up and removed from the homework room list. We will be sending out a reminder email on Tuesday to those students who are on the homework room list and expected to be in school on Wednesday.
